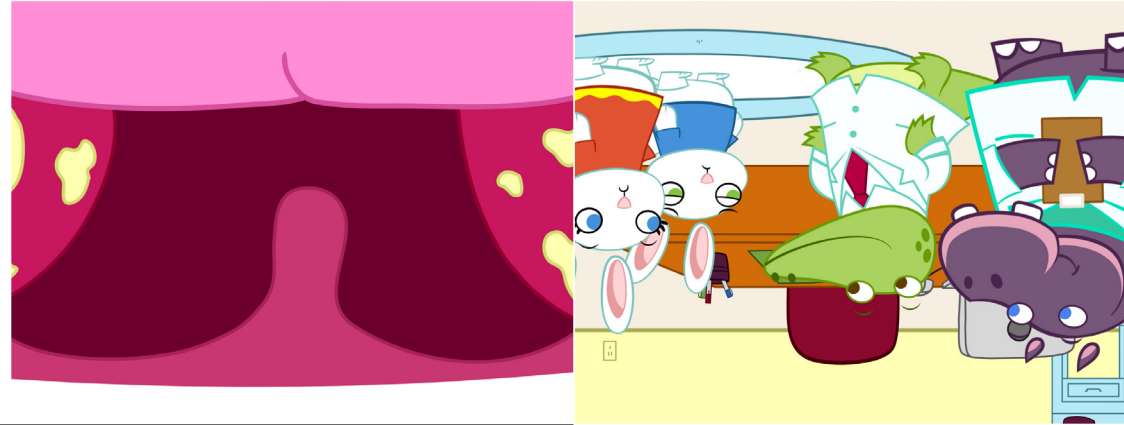

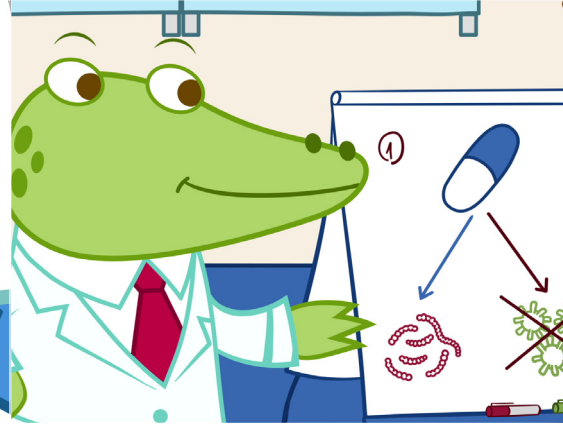

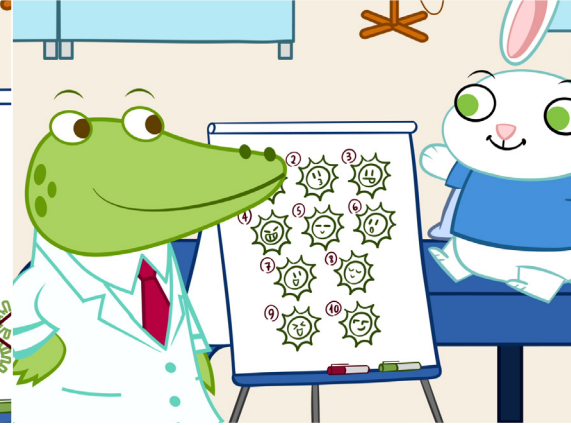
Tonsillitis can be caused by bacteria (which are so small they can only be seen with a microscope) or a virus.



To determine if Conny's tonsillitis is viral or bacterial, Croco Doc performs a test using his saliva.

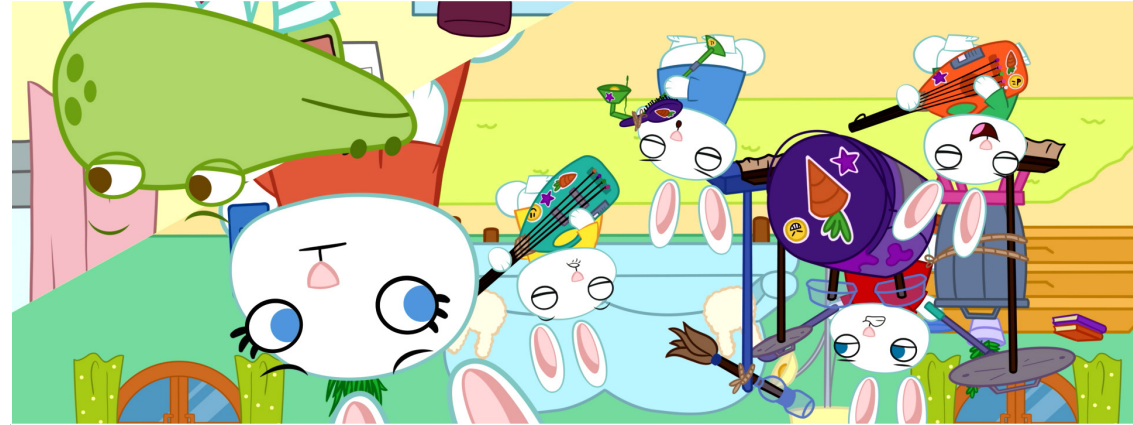


A while later, the result indicates that Conny's tonsillitis is caused by bacteria, so he'll need to take an antibiotic.
