



Never tilt the head backward.

Blood can accumulate, and unintentionally, you might swallow it, causing nausea.

It's better to tilt the whole body slightly forward, so the blood flows properly.

Also, consider the temperature.

Nosebleeds are more likely with sudden temperature changes and in very hot weather.
