They quickly approach to help Scott.

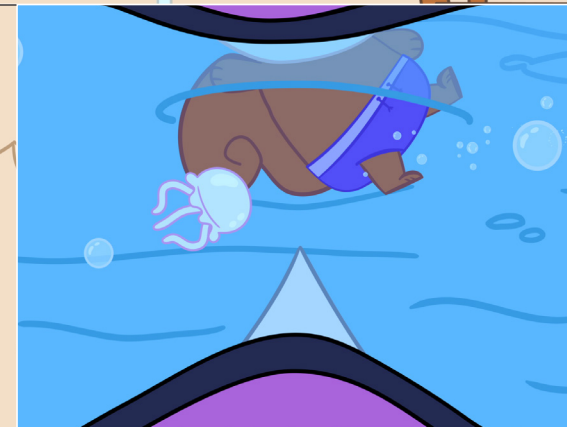
Luckyly, Croco Doc and Hippo Grat were also at the beach.

Finally, Croco Doc prescribes a
burn ointment and a pain syrup
for Scott.



The jellyfish sting has left red
scars, along with some white
threads:

Filaments from the jellyfish ten-
tacles.

The first thing to do is wash the
wound with seawater—never
with freshwater!

And it's crucial not to scratch.

It's also important to remove the
tentacles left in the wound.

Croco Doc carefully removes
them one by one with Mr. Bull's
tweezers.

Then, use ice to alleviate the
pain—make sure to enclose it in
a bag to prevent the wound from
getting wet with freshwater.
