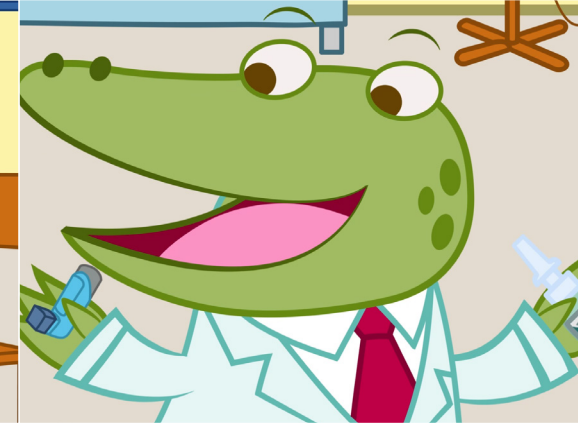


To be sure, Croco Doc needs to do a blood test first...

Nico is so afraid of needles that he faints!



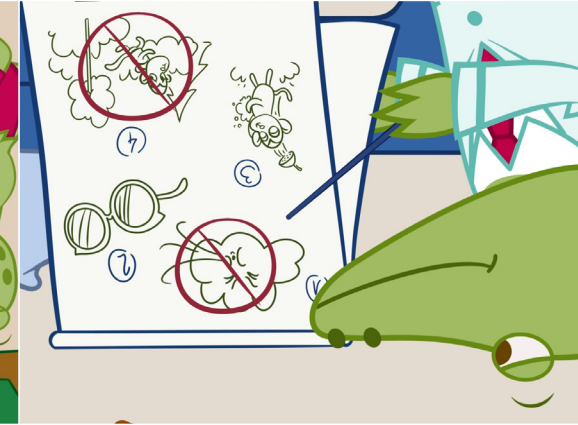
